ABOUT ANDRE: Andre D. Carroll was born and raised in Germantown and has organized at the state & city level for nearly a decade to make government work for us. He was raised by his grandmother, is a product of Philly Public Schools, and understands what it means to grow up in a neighborhood that's been left behind for way too long.

CAMPAIGN LAUNCH: Andre launched his campaign on December 9, 2023 with an overwhelming amount of grassroots support and a broad, multiracial, multigenerational coalition. 100+ community members from across the district and the city joined him with deafening applause and the program included speeches from Councilmember Isaiah Thomas, Councilmember-Elect Nicolas O'Rourke, and neighbor and activist TBah.

PATH TO VICTORY - DOORS, GRASSROOTS FUNDRAISING, LEVERAGING RELATIONSHIPS:

As a former campaign manager, Andre understands that a State House race is won at the doors and with a multi-racial, multi-generational coalition of grassroots support. Our team has a realistic and strategic plan to knock 15,000 doors, gain 2,000+ petition signatures, leverage relationships with unions and elected officials, and raise over \$150,000 by Election Day (April 23, 2024) – \$52,000 of which has already been raised as of Feb 1, 2024.

ABOUT THE DISTRICT - House District 201 contains Germantown, Logan, and parts of West Oak Lane. The district is majority Black with over 65,000 residents in total. The median household income is \$35,000 a year and the percentage of people living below the poverty line is over 30%. 47% of the residents are homeowners – most of which are in dire need of structural repair. 60% of the district is over 60 years old. The current State Rep in the seat (Stephen Kinsey) has [announced his retirement](#) and is not seeking re-election.



WE CAME CLOSE IN 2022, AND WILL BRING IT HOME IN 2024 - In 2022, Andre ran a competitive race in HD201 against a ten year incumbent. 1,200 petition signatures were collected, 10,000 doors were knocked, and 24 endorsements were received from unions, electeds, and community organizations. Andre garnered the support of over 43% of the voters and fell short by only 1,546 votes.

During his campaign launch, Andre addressed his reflections from his last run: *"In 2022, we started a conversation about having a progressive champion represent this district. Over 4,300 folks agreed with us. We came so close to winning. Since then I've thought a lot about those folks and about what happens if we don't double down on this conversation and come back for another fight. My deep rooted mission to serve includes leaving nobody behind. And that's why we're doing this again, and this time **I believe that we will win.**"*
